For the course of

### **CERTIFICATE IN HORTICULTURE**

The course comprises one year intensive training in the principles and practices of horticulture. There will be two theoretical and three practical papers on the fundamentals of horticulture and principles and practices of gardening. The session usually begins in the month of September / October and closes in September / October.

#### **Qualification for Admission**

Male candidate, who has attained the age of 16 years to 25 years on 31<sup>st</sup> of August of the year of admission and has successfully completed the Higher Secondary Examination (10 + 2) with Agriculture or Bio-Science with 50 % marks and possesses good health will be eligible for admission to this course. Selection for Admission will be made on the basis of marks obtained in the qualifying Examination and performance at the interview.

#### **Admission and Tuition Fees**

Application Form for admission may be collected from the office during August / September or by post. For this purpose, send one self-address envelope with postal stamp worth of Rs. 40/- for Speed Post along with the request letter, or download the Form from our Website (**Website: [www.agrihorticultureindia.com](http://www.agrihorticultureindia.com)**). There will be an Admission fee of Rs.100/- (Rupees One hundred only) payable at the time of admission and Tuition Fee of Rs.40/- (Rupees Forty only) payable in advance on the 10<sup>th</sup> day of each month. Establishment Fee of Rs.10/- (Rupees Ten only) per month is payable along with the tuition fee. Besides, each student will have to deposit Rs.100/- (Rupees One hundred) only as Caution Money at the time of admission which will be paid back to the student on completion of this course of training after deduction of any amount that may be charged due to breakage or loss of laboratory and garden equipment.

#### **Working Hours**

The daily programme of work of 8 (eight) hours will comprise of practical and theoretical classes from Monday to Saturday. The hours of work will be adjusted according to requirement. Sunday is the weekly off day. Society's holiday will be followed in Institute also.

#### **Accommodation**

The students will have to stay in the Hostel which will be provided free of cost. Arrangements for messing will have to be made by the students. No guests are allowed for night stay. Staying out, without permission, is not allowed. Maximum of 10 students will be admitted per session.
